Derby’s much-loved concert returns to Darley Park after a year’s break.

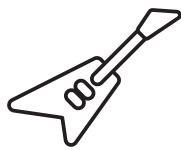

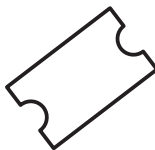

A treat for cricket fans! England return to Trent Bridge to face the West Indies in a one day international.




England are unbeaten in their last seven Tests in Nottingham with two Ashes triumphs among their six victories during that period.

Bess takes centre stage in this one-woman show mixing theatre with film.




Surprisingly, this is the first drama to capture this extraordinary woman and her extraordinary times.

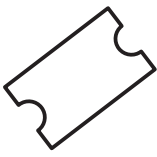

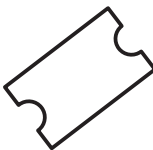

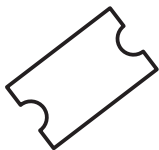

The festival began in 2006 and last year’s event was absolutely fantastic with the venues and streets of Hockley full of festival goers.

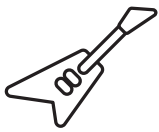
There’s always a great showing of rising local talent, as well as some bigger names, the line-ups yet to be confirmed so keep your eyes peeled!

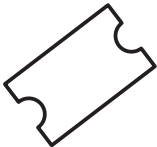

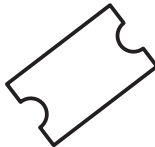
